Instructions Rear Swaybar Kit

N.B: This instruction sheet should be used in conjunction with the workshop manual and proper safety procedures followed.

- 1. Raise vehicle evenly and safely support.
- 2. Grease D bushing ID and position on swaybar.
- 3. Place supplied U bolts over Axle refer image 1.


Note - careful of any brake lines.

- 4. Using supplied 2x axle brackets, flat plates and saddles, hang swaybar under diff refer image 1. Assemble nuts and washers but do not tighten yet.
- 5. Raise swaybar towards chassis rail and locate link bracket hole bolt link bracket to chassis with supplied bolt and nut do not tighten yet refer image 2.
- 6. Assemble swaybar link;

Place 1 flat washer between the 2 inner link bushings. Place cupped link washers on the outer bushings only.

- Note Face cupped link washers away from link bushings. This will aid for articulation and assist bushing life. Do not over tighten link bushings
- 7. Check all nuts are now tight.
- 8. Road test and re-check all nuts and bolts.

Careful of brake lines




